## Subject: Nebraska Republican Party State Central Committee Brings Stabilizing Message for General Election and Endorses Candidates

Lincoln, NE – The Nebraska Republican Party's State Central Committee (SCC) delivered a message to ensure a stabilizing political front for the upcoming General Election by passing a resolution to unite on the core principles of the party and endorsing key candidates. This move underscores the party's commitment to accountability, transparency, conservative principles, fiscal responsibility, and the promotion of individual liberties.

The SCC adopted a Unity Resolution with the premise of consolidating support across the party and reinforcing its foundational values. The committee then passed a second resolution endorsing all five members of Nebraska's Federal Delegation in the General Election. The endorsement includes Pete Ricketts (U.S. Senate), Deb Fischer (U.S. Senate), Mike Flood (Congress District 1), Don Bacon (Congress District 2), and Adrian Smith (Congress District 3).

Chairman Underwood highlighted the importance of respecting the voice of the voters, stating, "In the representative process of primary elections, it is pertinent that we respect the voice of the voters; therefore, we support the candidates whom Republicans chose in the Primary Election. We are the party that is OF, BY, and FOR the PEOPLE. This resolution supports our foundational belief of being a party governed BY the voting PEOPLE."

In addition to the federal endorsements, the SCC also endorsed candidates for state and local offices, including: Robert Hallstrom (LD 1), Felix Ungerman (LD 3) Gilbert Ayala (LD 5), Roxie Kracl (LD 15), Mike Albrecht (LD 17), Jeanne Reigle (LD 19), Dennis Fujan (LD 23), Dawn Liphardt (LD 27), Dan Lonowski (LD 33) and Gwen Kautz (NPPD Dist. 6)

Chairman Underwood added, "The Nebraska Republican Party has worked diligently to develop and foster a relationship of good will and stability around the common objective of furthering our conservative principles throughout Nebraska and pursuing the greatest of common goals – unifying to re-elect Donald J. Trump as the 47th President of the United States".
